

## I-68 MADE EASY

As a courtesy to the local boating community the Port Townsend Yacht Club is sponsoring a Customs and Border Protection event to facilitate renewal or first time registration for I-68 forms. I-68 registration is intended to streamline and facilitate reentry of U.S. based boats back into the Country after traveling abroad. This event will take place on Thursday May 8 from 10 AM to 1 PM. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) inspectors will conduct personal interviews at the Port Townsend Yacht Club building at 2503 Washington Street. This event is open to the public.



You should complete a revised application form and drop it off at the Yacht Club or the CBP office in Port Townsend. (The CBP office is on the second floor of the main post office building in Port Townsend).

The revised application should be completed and dropped off by Monday May 5. Completing the application by this date will speed processing time for everyone on the day of the event.

As a reminder, bring the following with you to the interview on May 8:

1. Your current Washington Boat Registration Certification (Hull number, length, type, model, year, make, etc.);
2. Previous I-68 registration, if any;
3. One passport sized picture for each person obtaining the I-68 Form. New photos are not necessary if you bring your old registration with photo;
4. Your 2008 US Customs decal number for vessels 30 feet or greater. 2008 US Customs Decals cannot be purchased at the event, they must be purchased in advance via application obtained from the CBP office or online at [www.cbp.gov](http://www.cbp.gov) then clicking the "travel" tab, then "User Fee Decal Program", then "Apply Online for Decals". Cost for a Decal is \$27.50.
5. Passport or Passport number (even if expired) for each person obtaining an I-68.
6. There is a \$16.00 charge for each person obtaining an I-68. (\$32.00 total for a family with minor children).
7. Each person getting an I-68 must be present for the interview.
8. Payment must be made by personal check or cash for the exact amount. No credit cards are accepted, and no cash change can be made.
